The journey for this fun, exciting nursery began with the parents-to-be falling in love with the embossed, scalloped-edge, colorful Italian tile from Dune Ceramic Tile Company. With that in hand and knowing that the room was for a baby girl, Randall Crim of JRC Designs started with the “All About Me – Best of Friends” fabric with an international girlfriends theme – hand-in-hand and bejeweled with sparkle skirts, scarves and ribbons.

Cortec vinyl clad flooring provides easy maintenance for a child's room. The multi-colored star ceiling and striped wallpaper used as a drop border helps fill the room with a childlike sense of “fun” – a nursery this baby girl could grow into “until it's prom time,” as her father said.

The wall was turned into useful storage space plus an artistic focal point with a colorful brownstone building façade. The same sense of functionality went into creating the love seat ottoman – designed with a removable top for storage.

For babies and toddlers, a nursery bath/shower door is neither necessary nor practical and can be added later. That also allowed

incorporating the whimsical powder puff fabric to dress the tub area. The coveted crowning jewel in the nursery bath is the toddler commode – a must-have for potty training.

The colorful, wood-framed rocking chair was lacquered in violet, with the cushion upholstered in faux fur.

The changing table is actually a full-size dresser with ample storage drawers – with an added changing top. When no longer needed for that, it can evolve back into a dresser.

A multi-colored embroidered Missoni area rug offers the soon-to-be-crawling baby a comfortable playing area. The polka-dot 3-M window film on the large and eyebrow windows adds privacy and a design element. A sweeping flock of ceramic doves hovers above the crib. □
